SIP we were able to meet the dead-line. It will be our working document

We did great with the money. Account 220 will be a little higher than projected. We need to add about 2300 for Alison. The total will be about \$4,100. In the end we will have a carryover of 7300. Are we okay to save that? Yes, because we showed how we propose to use it next year. Do we remember what it will be used for? Yes, aides next year, and mastery connect conference for the teachers over the summer. It was good we spent almost everything.

Afterschool funding-

Funding is down, so we either need to change the structure or raise \$15,000. We've been successful in the program. Can we raise the money?

Currently we have 1 teacher that stays full-time from 2:30 until 5:00. If we change the structure that teacher would only be there from 2:30 until 4:00. A paraprofessional will be in charge for clubs. Jolyn-I don't have a good enough knowledge to say.

We service 65-100 kids a day- it is about 1/5th of the students. It is not all ESL, the needs vary, and some need extra help.

With a paraprofessional in charge the club becomes disconnected from the school day. The students become disrespectful, and the paraprofessional is not qualified to handle hard students. The misbehaviors happen during club time, not learning time. Where can we take the money? Not title one, stem levy, K-3, G/T- needs to be Trust land. Can Trust land not give all the money? Cort has said, that the money we give should be to benefit a majority of the students. After school club is a small portion. We can give a couple thousand as a good faith, that we will raise the money from elsewhere. Are there other options? There are private investors, donations. I can create a After School Club committee to talk about the options. We can restart the grant after next year. It is only this year that we need to think of other options.
